3. Registration and Payment

Upon your arrival at the Tokyo Metropolitan University (TMU), you need to register for the conference. Except for those who have received an exemption notice in the invitation letter, every participant is required to pay for the registration (Japanese Yen \mathbb{1}0,000 per person) and the post-conference excursion (\mathbb{1}3,000 per person) fees at the time of the registration.

Registration fee for the meeting: \$10,000 per person, including conference kits, welcome party, farewell party, and lunch-box on June 25, 26.

Fee for post-conference excursion: \[\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{13,000}\] per person, including bus fee, lunch-box, and dinner.

The above fees should be paid in Japanese Yen. Other currencies will not be accepted. Please note that we accept only cash in Japanese Yen.

5. Presenter Instructions and Requirements

The oral presentations (both symposium and sessions) are organized into 15-minute time-slots, including questions and discussion. Speakers are kindly requested to follow the instructions of the chairperson and strictly keep to the time limit of their presentation. Presenters are encouraged to give their presentation data to our assistants, providing a USB drive at the registration or at the latest, before the start of their session.

6. Guidelines for Poster presentation

Posters are on display throughout the meeting. The presentation time is from 9:00 to 18:00, on June 25 and 26. Please put up your poster on your poster board beginning in the early afternoon on June 24; remove your poster by 18:00, June 26. The authors are required to set up their material before the core-time starting at 13:30, on June 26. Please find your poster number on the poster board. Poster boards will be 94 x 175 cm in size (portrait orientation). Thumbtacks will be supplied by the organizer. During the poster session all authors should remain in front of the poster for questions and responses.

7. Post-Conference Excursion

We will visit Isehara- Hatano areas in Kanagawa Prefecture, about 1.5 hours away from the hotel in Hashimoto, on June 27. We will leave the hotel at 9:00 to visit the Upper Paleolithic site, where there is an ongoing rescue excavation, then visit a special exhibition of the Upper Paleolithic and Incipient Jomon collections from Kanagawa Prefecture at the Tana-Mukaihara Paleolithic Museum. Upon arrival at around noon, Lunchbox of light meal will be distributed. The order of the stops may change depending on the weather condition. We will have dinner at a French restaurant at TMU around 18:30.

8. Upon Arrival and Departure

We plan to meet with you at the lobby of both airports, Narita and Haneda, to support you in catching the ground transportation, going to the hotel, and finding the conference venue. Please inform us your flight number, arrival time, and the name of the terminal (Terminal 1 or 2 or 3 in Narita, or Haneda). After you come through the custom declaration out to the lobby, you can find our conference staffs waiting for you with a sign saying "8th APA."
